EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 52-A
Series of 2020

AN ORDER DECLARING BLOCK 3 AND PORTION OF BLOCK 5 OF BARANGAY 14, GINGOOG CITY UNDER LOCALIZED LOCKDOWN AND FOCUSED CONTAINMENT/COMMUNITY QUARANTINE TO PREVENT, CONTAIN AND MITIGATE THE IMPACT OF THE COVID-19 CONTAGION IN THE AREA

WHEREAS, Sec. 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates Local Government Units to, among others, promote the health and safety of their constituents;

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte through Proclamation No. 922 s. 2020, declared a state of public health emergency due to the rapid proliferation of COVID-19 in the country;

WHEREAS, the city government has consistently supported the programs of the national government in the fight against COVID-19 by closely collaborating with the concerned government agencies, the other local government units, including the barangays and the private sector in the adoption of appropriate programs and measures intended to prevent the possible local transmissions of the disease;

WHEREAS, on September 1, 2020, Dr. Agnes A. Centino, the Asst. City Health Officer and Unified Commander of the Gingoog City COVID-19 Task Force has recommended to the City Mayor to declare a 14-day localized lockdown in Block 3 and portion of Block 5 in Brgy. 14, Gingoog City after it has reported the first 3 confirmed cases of local transmission of COVID-19 in the City specifically in the aforementioned areas;

WHEREAS, there is a need to lockdown Block 3 and portion of Block 5 in Brgy. 14, Gingoog City in order immediately prevent, contain and mitigate the impact of the COVID-19 infection in the area;

WHEREAS, prior coordination with the Department of Health had already been sought for immediate technical assistance and guidance to appropriately manage the urgent situation in the locality;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ERICK G. CAÑOSA, Mayor of the City of Gingoog, Province of Misamis Oriental, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. LOCALIZED LOCKDOWN. Block 3 and portion of Block 5 in Brgy. 14, Gingoog City are hereby placed under localized lockdown and focused containment / community quarantine whereby movement (incoming or outgoing) of all persons within the area is strictly restricted starting 5PM of September 1, 2020 until further notice.

SECTION 2. ZONING CONTAINMENT STRATEGY. In implementing the localized lockdown, the Zoning Containment Strategy which is a localized rapid response operation to contain the spread of COVID-19 as a preventive option for intervention shall be adopted as follows:

- a. The lockdown area shall be categorized into the following four (4) zoning classifications: (Use NTF MC No. 2, s. 2020 as a guide)
- 1) Critical Zone – 100-meter radius from Taneo residence in Block 3 and portion of Block 5, Brgy. 14, Gingoog City.
 - 2) Containment Zone – 200-meter radius from Taneo residence in Block 3 and portion of Block 5, Brgy. 14, Gingoog City
 - 3) Buffer Zone – 300-500 meter radius from Taneo residence in Block 3 and portion of Block 5, Brgy. 14, Gingoog City
 - 4) Areas Outside Buffer Zone – areas beyond 500-meter radius
- b. The zoning classifications shall be applied to the following, but not limited to:
- 1) Taneo residence
 - 2) Grahe Sidewalk Grill, Encabo Store, and Daamo Store
 - 3) Condeza St., Gomez St.,
 - 4) Block 3, and Portion of Block 5,
 - 5) Barangay 14
 - 6) Gingoog City

SECTION 3. TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ALL GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE FACILITIES/ESTABLISHMENTS. All government and private facilities/ establishments located in the affected areas, except hospitals, and pharmacies, shall be closed in the entire duration of the lockdown.


SECTION 4. OBSERVANCE OF HEALTH PROTOCOLS. All government and private facilities/establishments allowed to remain open shall strictly enforce standard health protocols such as social distancing, wearing of face masks, gloves and other personal protective equipment, and adopt skeletal staffing, among others required by the Department of Health.

SECTION 5. ENFORCEMENT. The City Joint Task Force Corona Virus Shield composed of the Philippine National Police, Armed Forces of the Philippines, Bureau of Fire Protection, and Philippine Coast Guard, along with the Barangay Tanods, are hereby directed to strictly enforce this Executive Order.

Failure to abide by this Executive Order shall be meted with appropriate action in accordance with relevant laws and regulations. The City Legal Officer is instructed to initiate appropriate charges against violators.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY. This order shall take effect immediately and shall be implemented for fourteen (14) days only.
