EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 64
Series of 2020.

**AN ORDER ADOPTING IATF-EID RESOLUTION NO. 72 SERIES OF 2020
AND PROVIDING GUIDELINES ON THE OBSERVANCE OF UNDAS 2020.**

WHEREAS, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) has issued Resolution No. 72 series of 2020 dated September 17, 2020 which shall govern all activities relating to the Observance of Undas season in all private and public cemeteries, memorial parks, including columbariums and the like;

WHEREAS, the Gingoog City COVID-19 Task Force has agreed that the guidelines provided in the said Resolution are in order and considered it necessary to adopt the said guidelines to prevent the spread of coronavirus disease in Gingoog City;

NOW, THEREFORE, I ERICK G. CAÑOSA, by the virtue of the power vested in me by law as City Mayor of Gingoog, do hereby issue this Executive Order and declare the following:

Section 1: DECLARATION. It is hereby ordered to adopt IATF-EID Resolution No. 72 series of 2020 and further declare that the number of visitors in all private and public cemeteries, memorial parks in Gingoog City, including columbariums and the like during the observance of the Undas or Kalag-kalag season shall be limited to a maximum of thirty percent (30%) of the venue capacity at a given time and all visitors shall wear facemasks, face shields, and shall observe social distancing.

Section 2. CLOSURE OF ALL PRIVATE AND PUBLIC CEMETERIES, MEMORIAL PARKS IN GINGOOG CITY, INCLUDING COLUMBARIUMS AND THE LIKE. From October 29, 2020 up to November 4, 2020, all private and public cemeteries, memorial parks in Gingoog City, including columbariums and the like shall be closed to all visitors. Further, the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine shall continue to govern burial and cremation activities during the said period.

Section 3. ENFORCEMENT. The officers and members of the Philippine National Police and the Bureau of Fire Protection, the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (CDRRMO), and the Philippine Red

Cross- Gingoog City Chapter are mandated to strictly enforce the guidelines provided in this Order.


Section 4: PENALTY CLAUSE: Any violations hereof shall be dealt with under existing laws and ordinances.

Section 5: REPEALING CLAUSE: Any Executive Order not consistent with this Order is hereby amended or repealed.

Section 6: SEPARABILITY CLAUSE: In case any provision of this Order shall be declared invalid, illegal or unenforceable by higher authorities or by the Courts, the validity, legality, and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not in any way be affected or impaired.

Section 7: EFFECTIVITY: This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
