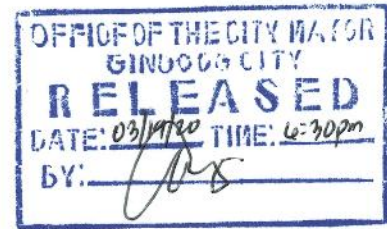

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 20
Series of 2020.

AN ORDER TO STRICTLY IMPLEMENT THE NEW CITY-WIDE CURFEW HOURS FROM 8PM TO 4AM AND OTHER GUIDELINES TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 TO BE ENFORCED IN THE ENTIRE CITY OF GINGOOG EFFECTIVE 8PM OF MARCH 20, 2020 UP TO APRIL 14, 2020.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 16 of the Local Government Code (LGC) of 1991 or the General Welfare Clause, Local Government Units within their territorial jurisdiction shall promote the health and safety of the people;

WHEREAS, last week, the President has placed the entire country under the State of Public Health Emergency due to the alarming threats posed by the Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) through Proclamation No. 922;

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, President Rodrigo R. Duterte has declared a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to Corona virus disease through Proclamation No. 929;

WHEREAS, the entire province of Misamis Oriental is also placed under the State of Calamity due to Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pursuant to Sangguniang Panlalawigan Resolution No. 344-2020; and the City of Gingoog has adopted the said Resolution declaring the entire City under the State of Calamity through SP Resolution No.2020-101;

WHEREAS, there is a need for an immediate, aggressive and proactive action by the local government to prevent the spread of corona virus disease in Gingoog City so as not to endanger the lives, health, and the livelihood of all Gingoognons;

NOW THEREFORE, I ERICK G. CAÑOSA, by the virtue of the power vested in me by law as City Mayor of Gingoog, do hereby issue this Executive Order and request the following:

Section 1: DECLARATION. It is hereby declared to strictly implement the new city-wide curfew hours from 8pm to 4am and other guidelines to prevent the spread of Covid-19 to be enforced in the entire City of Gingoog effective 8PM of March 20, 2020 up to April 14, 2020 unless extended or shortened upon the recommendation of the Gingoog City Covid-19 Task Force.

Section 2: POLICIES AND GUIDELINES:

- a. Frontline offices such as CHO, CDRRMO, CSWD, GSO, PNP, AFP, BFP etc. and members of the Gingoog City Covid-19 Task Force are mandated to maintain round-the-clock operations, provided that precautionary measures are strictly followed;
- b. The City shall implement a new city-wide curfew hours for all ages from 8pm to 4am in conformity with Resolution No. 03 series of 2020 issued by the Alliance Against Covid-19 from the Municipality of Jasaan to Magsaysay, Misamis Oriental. All establishments should be closed during curfew hours except the hospitals, medical facilities, pharmacies and other related establishments. Applicable provisions of City Ordinance No. 2016-290 and Executive Order No. 19 on curfew hours are still in effect;
- c. During curfew hours, private vehicles as well as motorelas, tricycles/trisikad, and motorcycles are prohibited from traveling within or going out from the city except for emergency and other humanitarian reasons. The city government shall assign standby vehicles for all passengers who just came to city at the Gingoog City Bus Terminal;
- d. The implementation of check-points established in all strategic locations in Gingoog City under Executive Order No. 18 series of 2020 shall remain in force and effect.;
- e. Cargo trucks, vans and other vehicles delivering food, medicines, medical supplies, fuels, goods and other commodities are allowed entry at anytime but the driver and his helper will be subject to profiling at the checkpoints and inspection protocols provided under Executive Order No. 18 series of 2020;
- f. During this period, everyone is strongly discouraged from going out of their houses if they do not have important transactions outside. They may come out to work, buy medicines and other commodities, go to the hospitals, and do other urgent matters. Barangay Captains and Officials are hereby mandated to ensure that their constituents are following the stay-at home policy of the Department of Health (DOH) and shall not allow them to loiter;
- g. All returning residents who come to stay in the city shall be required to present their valid government issued IDs or any competent evidence of their identity bearing their city address at the check points. They will be subjected to inspection protocols provided under Executive Order No. 18 series of 2020 and shall be assessed as *Persons Under Monitoring (PUM)* who shall be required to undergo mandatory self-quarantine for at least 14-days.

- h. All non-residents who come to stay in the city for a legitimate cause or other humanitarian reasons will undergo profiling conducted by the representatives of the Gingoog City Covid-19 Task Force, PNP, and AFP. There shall be forms to be filled up and the same shall be surrendered to the authorities while queuing up at the checkpoints. They will be subjected to inspection protocols provided under Executive Order No. 18 series of 2020 and shall be assessed as *Persons Under Monitoring (PUM)* who shall be required to undergo mandatory self-quarantine for at least 14-days;
- i. The suspension of classes under Executive Order No. 17 series of 2020 and the cancellation of all mass gatherings provided under City Government of Gingoog Guidelines No. 2 for the prevention of Corona Virus (Covid-19) are still in effect;
- j. Selling and drinking of liquors or any alcoholic beverages in public places and commercial establishments at any time of the day or night are strictly prohibited upon the effectivity of this order;
- k. Operations of beer houses, KTV bars, disco bars, cockpits, internet cafes, computer gaming shops, piso net shops, vape shops and other similar establishments are suspended until further notice;
- l. All activities that require mass gatherings are hereby suspended.

Section 3: Penalty Clause: Any violations hereof shall be dealt with under existing laws and ordinances.

Section 4: Repealing Clause: Any Executive Order not consistent with this Order is hereby amended or repealed.

Section 5: Separability Clause: In case any provision of this Order shall be declared invalid, illegal or unenforceable, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not in any way be affected or impaired.

Section 5: Effectivity: This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
