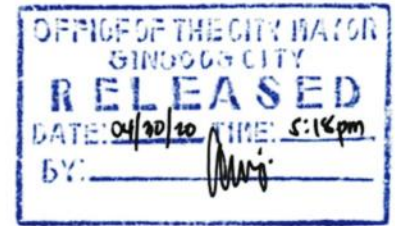

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 28
Series of 2020.

AN ORDER EXTENDING FURTHER THE DECLARATION OF THE GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE IN THE ENTIRE CITY OF GINGOOG UP TO MAY 15, 2020.

WHEREAS, the President has placed the entire country under the State of Public Health Emergency due to the alarming threats posed by the Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) through Proclamation No. 922

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, President Rodrigo R. Duterte has declared a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to Coronavirus disease through Proclamation No. 929;

WHEREAS, under Section 16 of the Local Government Code (LGC) of 1991 or the General Welfare Clause, Local Government Units within their territorial jurisdiction shall promote the health and safety of the people;

WHEREAS, Section 455 (b) (vii) of the Local Government Code provides that for efficient, effective and economical governance the purpose of which is the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants the city mayor has the power to carry out such emergency measures as may be necessary during and in the aftermath of man-made and natural disasters and calamities;

WHEREAS, on April 8, 2020, by virtue of Executive Order No. 26 series of 2020, the declaration of the General Community Quarantine in the entire City of Gingoog was extended up to April 30, 2020;

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2020, Presidential Spokesperson Harry Roque announced that President Rodrigo R. Duterte has approved the recommendation of the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Disease (IATF-MEID) to extend the enhanced community quarantine in the National Capital Region (NCR), CALABARZON and other "high-risk" areas in the country until May 15, 2020;

WHEREAS, the IATF-MEID also recommended that "moderate-risk" areas including the province of Misamis Oriental will be under General Community Quarantine until May 15, 2020;

WHEREAS, just today, the IATF-MEID has issued the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of the General Community Quarantine;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the said recommendation of IATF-MEID which classified the province of Misamis Oriental as one of the "moderate-risk" areas in

the country, it is imperative upon the city government to further extend the declaration of the General Community Quarantine in the entire City of Gingoog.

NOW, THEREFORE, I ERICK G. CAÑOSA, by the virtue of the power vested in me by law as City Mayor of Gingoog, do hereby issue this Executive Order and declare the following:

Section 1: DECLARATION. It is hereby ordered to extend further the effectivity of Executive Order No. 21 series of 2020 declaring a General Community Quarantine in the entire City of Gingoog up to May 15, 2020.

- a. The Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of the General Community Quarantine issued by the IATF-MEID is hereby adopted and shall be made an integral part hereof;
- b. Moreover, the provisions of the following orders, which are not inconsistent with the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of the General Community Quarantine, shall likewise be extended up to May 15, 2020, to wit:
 1. The order establishing Check-Points in various strategic locations in the City to prevent the spread of COVID-19 under Executive Order No. 18 series of 2020;
 2. The order to strictly implement the new city-wide curfew hours from 8 pm to 4 am and other guidelines to prevent the spread of COVID-19 to be enforced in the entire City of Gingoog under Executive Order No. 20 series of 2020; and
 3. The order imposing a 12-hour curfew for all minors in the entire City of Gingoog from 5 pm to 5 am under Executive Order No. 23 series of 2020.
- c. The following orders shall continue to take effect:
 1. The order of suspension of classes in all levels in both private and public schools under Executive Order No. 17 series of 2020 shall remain in effect until an Order/Memorandum/Issuance coming from the Department of Education (DepEd) and/or Commission on Higher Education (CHED) declaring the resumption of classes;
 2. However, Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) may hold classes through flexible learning arrangements to finish the Academic Year 2019-2020, and may operate at a limited capacity to receive students' requirements and prepare and issue credentials to students subject to the guidelines as may be issued by the Commission on Higher Education;
 3. The order mandating every person within the territorial jurisdiction of Gingoog City to wear facemask at all times when going out of their residences, at the workplace, entering government offices and while in public places under

Executive Order No. 25 series of 2020 shall continue to be in full force and effect until the State of Public Health Emergency shall be lifted or withdrawn by the President or by other higher authorities;

- d. The provisions of City Government of Gingoog Guidelines numbers 1 to 5 for the prevention of coronavirus disease (COVID-19) which do not conflict with the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of the General Community Quarantine and other existing orders and guidelines shall continue to take force and effect unless declared otherwise by this office or by higher authorities.
- e. Resolutions issued or to be issued by the IATF-MEID on the guidelines of the General Community Quarantine shall also be made an integral part hereof.


Section 2: PENALTY CLAUSE: Any violations hereof shall be dealt with under existing laws and ordinances.

Section 3: REPEALING CLAUSE: Any Executive Order not consistent herewith is hereby amended or repealed.

Section 4: SEPARABILITY CLAUSE: In case any provision of this Order shall be declared invalid, illegal or unenforceable by higher authorities or by the Courts, the validity, legality, and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not in any way be affected or impaired.

Section 5: EFFECTIVITY: This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
